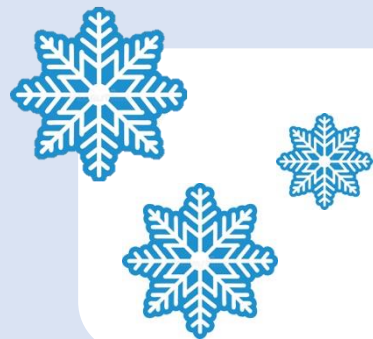




Year 4/5
