Science

Science

Can you use books or a computing device to look up different animals in different animal groups? You could draw sorting circles and group the animals into amphibians, mammals, reptiles, fish, birds and insects. Write two facts about each animal group.

RE

In RE we are looking at Christianity and asking the question 'Does how we treat the world matter?'. Can you make your own poster to say how we would look after our world?

Literacy

PSHE
