Geography: Research how animals survive in hot or cold places. Create a mini fact file or poster.	Science: Choose 10 different animals from books, the internet or toys. Sort them into mammals, birds, fish, reptiles' amphibians and insects. Compare two animal groups and write how they are same and different.	Art: Create a 3D model of a hot or cold place using recycled materials. Write a short explanation of how your model shows what life is like in that place.
Geography: Compare two places like the Sahara Desert and Antarctica. What do people wear, eat, and do there? Draw or write your ideas.	Reading: Read a non-fiction book about a hot or cold place. Write 3 facts you learned.	Maths: Create a weather chart for a week. Record the temperature each day (you can use a weather app or make up your own). Write the temperature in °C
Geography: Find the North Pole, South Pole, and Equator on a map. Label a map with the North Pole, South Pole, and the Equator. What's the weather like in each?	Art: Design two outfits — one for a hot place and one for a cold place. Label the clothes and explain why they're just right.	Art: Paint or draw a scene showing how people live in a hot or cold place. Think about houses, clothes, and transport.
Geography: Look at a map or globe together. Can you spot a hot place and a cold place? Draw what people might wear there.	Religious Education Draw or write one way you can be a light to others, just like Jesus — maybe by being kind, helping someone, or telling the truth.	Trust: Chat about someone your child trusts. They can draw that person and write: "I trust __ because __."
