Curriculum

Geography: This half term, we will be learning about deserts and what it would be like to live in one, including the advantages and disadvantages of doing so.

Maths: We will be developing our geometry skills by solving problems using coordinates, as well as the reflection and translation of shapes. In addition, we will hone our mental and written multiplication and division skills. Our arithmetic skills will be practiced daily through Fluent in Five.

PE: On Mondays, our BFC coach, Caitlyn, will be teaching year 6 striking and fielding skills. We are also fortunate enough to have another coach from RSSP to teach us dance on a Wednesday!

DT: We will continue our DT project which will be based on structures, where we will be designing playground equipment during the first week.

Art: Our art topic will be based on turning 2d images of desert creatures into 3d models and how to use texture to bring our artwork to life!



RE: This half term, our focus will be on Christianity, particularly Holy Week and Easter.

PSHE: We will be working on our Happy Minds program, where we learn all about our brains and how they are wired to enable us to cope better with various situations.

Homework Tasks.

- 1 piece of English per week
- 1 piece of Maths per week
- Reading AT LEAST once per week.
- TTRS practice weekly
- Learning of **spelling words** on the Y3/4 and Y4/5 lists (or alternate if provided by the staff in class).

The English and Maths tasks will be due in on a Friday rather than a Wednesday (as was the case last half term).

TTRS is checked every Thursday evening ready for TTRS certificates on a Friday.

Reading is checked daily- **remember we cannot mark your child as having read at home if they do not bring in their reading record or if it has not been signed.**
