Helmets

In DT we will be looking at Helmets. Create a brand-new helmet for a sport or activity of your choice.

- Draw/build the helmet
- Label the materials you would use (e.g., hard plastic, foam padding, straps)
- Add one special feature (e.g., a light, bright colours, a visor, reflective strips)
- Give your helmet a name

Create a River in a Tray

Task: Use a tray and household objects to create a river in a tray!

Follow the attached instructions and answer the questions in your homework book or on the sheet.

Rivers in Real Life

Choose one real river (e.g., the Thames, Nile, Amazon, Irwell). Create a simple fact card with:

A drawing or printed picture of the river

Where the river is

One interesting fact (e.g., longest, busiest, oldest bridge, animals found there)

One way people use that river (transport, fishing, drinking water, farming, energy)

Sugar in foods

Choose **3–5 foods or drinks** from home (for example: cereal, yoghurt, juice, biscuits, ketchup)

For each item:

- Find the **nutrition label** on the packet.
- Look for the line that says “**Carbohydrates – of which sugars**” and write down **how many grams of sugar** are in **one serving**.
- Draw a picture of the food next to your notes.

RE – Lent

In RE we are going to be looking at Christianity with a focus on Lent.

Describe what a Christian might do during Lent and why. Have you given anything up? What is it? Why are you giving it up? How is it going?

Design your own River

Create an imaginary river on paper and give it a name. Include:

- A source (e.g., a mountain, spring, or lake)
- A winding river path
- Features such as bridges, boats, animals, waterfalls, or towns
- A key showing what each symbol means

Forgiveness

Think of a way of representing this half term's Christian value of forgiveness.

How do people use rivers?

Make a list of at least 5 different ways people use rivers. Add a drawing next to each one.

Teamwork

In PE we will be focusing on Teamwork and Problem Solving. Can you design your own teamwork challenge such as moving a teddy from 1 room to another without using your hands? Can you complete it with a family member?

Recall the 3, 4, 6 and 8 x tables with related division facts

Know all your multiplication and division facts for the above tables. Either collect a times table sheet and complete or record the tables in your homework book.

Practice your spellings

Look at your spelling list in your homework book. Use one of the ways from the spelling menu to practice your spellings in your homework book.

In music we will be listening to The Dragon song. This is a song about kindness, respect, friendship, acceptance and happiness. Find a song that represents one of these values and explain why you think it does.
