Choose your homework from the menu below:

The Peri-ometer suggests the difficulty or challenge the homework may offer. Each week you must choose your task from the menu ensuring that at least one 'EXTRA HOT' task is completed over the half term!

These homework tasks are in addition to spellings, Times Table Rockstars, phonics activities and home reading tasks.



Get creative!

Task: Create your own piece of Roman armour, weapon, jewellery or dress. Make sure you research your creation as I will ask questions!

Challenge: Include a fact sheet telling me all about your creation.

Create a Roman God fact file

Task: Find out about some of the Roman Gods and Goddesses. Can you create a fact file about different ones. Include what they looked like, what they were the God of, how they were worshipped and any interesting facts.

Challenge: Can you include 3 or more Gods or Goddesses? Could you present it in an unusual way?

Roman Mosaic

Task: Create a Roman mosaic. You could use small squares of paper or real tiles, or just colour onto squared paper (ask Mrs World for some). What design will you use?

Challenge: Add information about your mosaic

Bone Fact Cards

Task: Make 5 "fact cards" about different bones (e.g., "The femur is the longest bone in the body").

Challenge: Add a labelled diagram including all the bones you have mentioned

RE

In RE we are going to be looking at Sikhism. Create a colourful poster showing Sikh values such as *sharing* (*vand chakna*), *helping others* (*sewa*), and *honesty* (*kirat karna*).

Collage

In art we are going to be creating our own collages. Could you collage your own Roman shield or soldier? What materials will you use?

Hope

Think of a way of representing this half term's Christian value of hope.

Draw and label an ancient Roman soldier

Can you draw and label your own Roman soldier. What clothing and equipment will he have? What about his weapons? Can you add any facts about Roman soldiers?

French Numbers

Can you find out the names of the numbers in French? Write them in your homework book with the correct number in English. How about creating your own French number counting game?

Recall the 2, 5, 10, 3 and 4 x tables with related division facts

Know all your multiplication and division facts for the above tables. Either collect a times table sheet and complete or record the tables in your homework book

Practice your spellings

Look at your spelling list in your homework book. Use one of the ways from the spelling menu to practice your spellings in your homework book
