Go Diwali

This half term we will be looking at Diwali in RE. Can you create your own Rangoli pattern using crayon, chalk or natural materials? Either create it in your homework book or take a photograph and add it in.

Write a diary entry

Imagine you are a Tudor or Victorian child and write a diary of your day. What did you do? What did you eat? Did you go to school?

States of Matter poster

Create a poster showing the three states of matter and explaining what they are.

Design an outfit

Design an outfit for a Victorian or Tudor child. Think about the types of clothes they would wear in each period.
Tudor: ruffs, wool, leather shoes
Victorian: pinafores, caps, boots

Music

In music we will be focusing on a song called Hands, Feet, Heart, which is a song written for children to celebrate and learn about South African Music. Can you find any songs from other countries/cultures. Write the title of the song and any other information about it in your homework book. Draw a picture of how the song made you feel.

Art

In music we will be using charcoal to draw pictures. What materials can you find to draw with? What picture will you create? Can you explain what you have drawn and why?

Find a fable

In literacy we will be looking at fables this half term. Can you find a fable and write a summary of it in your homework book. What is the moral behind your fable?

Our Christian value this half term is Thankfulness. How can you show your thanks?
