Novel as a theme:

Children will be able to; develop a new story outline based on an existing plot structure; use drama techniques to explore a new character or events from different points of view.

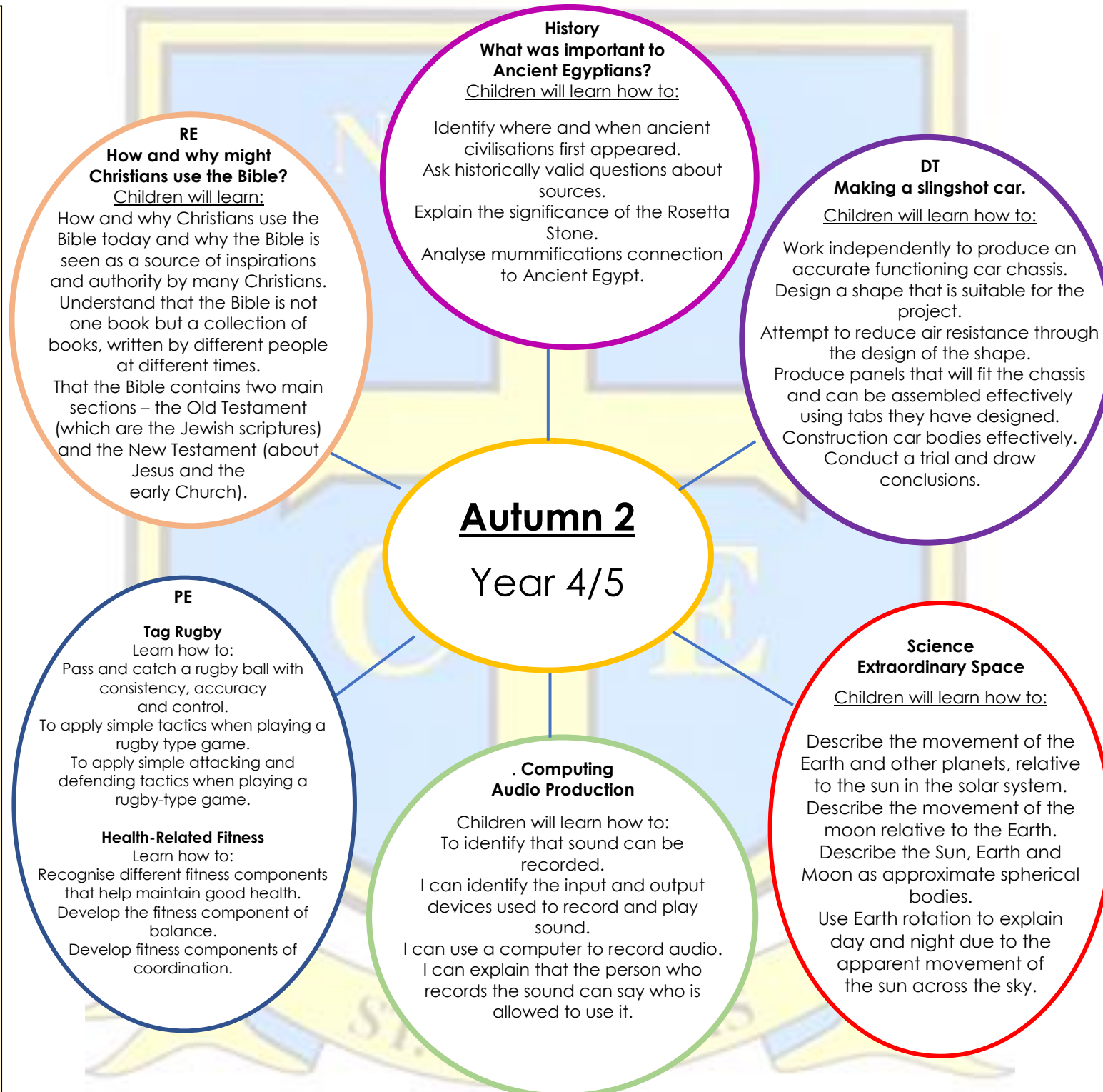
Children will be able to; write a story with an issue, problem or dilemma which includes fronted adverbials for 'where'; Standard English verb inflections with appropriate pronouns e.g. first person; and an opening paragraph which combines characters and setting.

Poems on a theme:

Children will be able to use apostrophes for singular and plural possession; listen to, and appreciate poems; specify reasons and justify preferences; explore vocabulary and discuss meanings in context; use drama techniques to represent a poem; perform a poem.

Children will be able to plan a piece of writing linked to a poem.

Children will be able to respond to poetry through a creative written outcome.
